

More Information of our Benefit Fund Raisers

If you are not aware, Shannon, our bartender, has a grandson that was born with a heart defect. He was born locally then transported to Gainesville where he spent a week in hospital. The defect is correctable, but here in Florida it will require 3 separate operations. There is a clinic and Doctor in California that can correct the defect with only one operation. The family has decided to go to California for the operation. They will be going in October when the baby is 9 months old. They need to drive because of the baby's condition. The dad and mom are both going out but after the operation the dad must come home to get back to work. The mom and baby will need to remain out there for 3 weeks after the operation. This is going to be an expensive trip for them so we are holding some fund raisers to help with the costs. There will be a Shrimp Boil on September 10th starting at 2:00 with a bouncy house and water slide for the kids. On September 16th, we are having a yard sale starting at 8:00. If you have anything you would like to donate you can bring it to the post on the 15th or take it by Southern Storage on Back Beach Road. Southern Storage has donated a climate controlled storage shed for us to keep things until the yard sale. We will need help on the 15th to move the stuff collected from the storage shed to the post starting around 10:00. If you have anything you would like to donate but don't have a way to get it to the post please let us know at the post and we will arrange to pick it up. If you would like to make a monetary donation please make checks payable to VFW Post 10555 and on the memo line put "Baby Dash Fund".

We have donation jars at the post to help Dallas. The Commander has been in touch with the San Antonio VFW. They survived but 4 in Houston did not. They are creating packages to send to the VFWs that got destroyed. The Commander is going to match all money collected and send it out to support these other VFWs. Please give generously.
